Located near Oxford Circus tube station, the Hall is renowned for its intimacy, acoustic and beautiful interior complete with an Arts and Crafts cupola above the stage – has a capacity of 552 seats, but draws in audiences from far and wide through its use of digital media and its ambitious Learning programme.

Since 1994, Wigmore Hall's renowned Learning programme has been giving people of all ages and backgrounds opportunities to take part in creative music making, engaging a broad and diverse audience through innovative creative projects, concerts, workshops and digital content.

We are passionate about the impact music can have on our lives and on our society, and three core values lie at the heart of our programme: **care**, **collaboration** and **equity**. These values reflect the spirit of music, and we embody them through **quality, co-created music making**, through which every voice is heard and equally valued.

We collaborate with a range of community, education, arts, health and social care organisations, working in partnership to engage people who might not otherwise have the opportunity to take part.
